## PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

The aim of the course is to enable students to understand the economic logic and economic principles of safety and prevention. Students need to understand the essence of the economic models used for predicting the behavior of individuals and legal entities in different risk situations that endanger safety. On this basis, they should understand the normative assessment of various safety rules, according to the criterion of minimizing the social cost of accidents (damage costs, the costs of prevention and administrative costs).

The basic model of liability for negligence of individuals and prevention. The basic model of liability for negligence of legal entities and prevention. Different factors of negligence and lowering the risk of damage. Causality and extent of liability for negligence (economic aspect). Economic analysis of damage and compensation. Other topics in the economic analysis of liability for negligence and prevention of damage (several wrongdoers, the problem of compensation for damage due to lack of property of perpetrators, etc). Theory of insurance and risk allocation. Responsibility, taking risks and insurance - the basic model. Responsibility, taking risks and insurance - expanded model. The legal regime of liability for negligence, safety and administrative costs. The legal regime of liability for negligence and different approaches to risk control.
