PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

The course aims to develop scientific knowledge and academic skills in understanding the nature of the economic system and the way of functioning of the European Union. The course is methodologically designed to enable students to supplement the knowledge acquired at the undergraduate level and obtain thorough knowledge about the economic system regulations and decisions of the European Union. Upon completion of this course, students will be able : 1) to understand the structure and process of economic and system solutions of the European Union; 2) to develop a systematic approach to the law of the economic system of the EU; 3) to **develop** a critical approach to the regulation of economic system relations within the European Union; 4) to disseminate the knowledge and conclusions to professional and general public.

Fiscal rules in the European Union and the implementation of the Pact on Stability and Growth Pact. Acceptance of systemic economic solutions by the EU non-member countries. and social policy.
