PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

Aims: to develop scientific knowledge, academic skills and practical skills in the interpretation and application of international and national regulations in the field of criminal law; to develop creative abilities and master the methods, procedures and processes of research and application of principles, concepts and institutes in the field of criminal law; to master specific legal skills in the system of criminal protection of goods and values, in accordance with modern tendencies and directions of development of domestic and foreign scientific thought in the field of criminal law as a scientific discipline, and to develop personal responsibility of prospective legal professionals and holders of judicial functions.

SYLLABUS (brief outline and summary of topics, max. 10 sentences)

General part: The concept, subject, title, sources, principles, classification and historic development of criminal law and criminal law doctrines. Concept and elements of a crime offence; Object and subject of offence; Legal basis for excluding criminal offense; Concept, elements and legal basis for exclusion of guilt. Stages in the commission of criminal offenses. Forms of crime. Concept, characteristics and forms of complicity in criminal offence. Concept, characteristics, historical development, purpose and types of criminal sanctions. Concept, elements, types, characteristics and rules for imposing a sentence. Cautionary measures (suspended sentence and judicial admonition). Security measures. Specific criminal measures. Rehabilitation and criminal records. Legal grounds for extinguishing criminal sanctions. Concept, characteristics and types of juvenile criminal sanctions: educational measures, juvenile prison and diversion orders.

Specific part: The basic characteristics of the special part of criminal law. Crimes against life and limb; Crimes against freedom, human and citizen rights; Crimes against electoral rights; Crimes against labour rights; Crimes against honour and reputation; Crimes against sexual freedom; Crimes related to marriage and family; Crimes against intellectual property; Offences against property; Offences against economy; Criminal offenses against public health; Criminal offences against environment; Criminal offenses against general safety of people and property; Offences against public traffic safety; Criminal acts against security of computer data; Criminal acts against constitutional order and security of the Republic of Serbia; Criminal acts against state authorities; Criminal acts against the judiciary; Criminal offenses against public peace and order; Criminal offenses against legal instruments; Criminal offenses against official duty; Crimes against humanity and other rights protected by international law; Criminal offenses against the Army of Serbia.
