PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

Aims: to acquire knowledge about all essential institutes, categories and phenomena of the tax system of Serbia; to introduce students to all stages of tax procedure and acquire relevant tax terminology; to train students to interpret tax regulations and fill out tax application forms; to develop abilities for critical analysis of positive tax legislation of Serbia; to acquire broader knowledge as a preparation for tax consulting.

Tax procedure in Serbia (notion, principles, participants, stages and legal means in the tax procedure). Rights and obligations (legal status) of tax payers in Serbia. Tax delicts (tax violations and tax criminal offences) in Serbia.
