

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

for the First South East European (SEE) Post-Doc Colloquium in Private Law

The First SEE Post-Doc Colloquium in Private Law will take place at the Faculty of Law in Zagreb (Croatia) on 27th and 28th of September 2012. It will be organized within the framework of the South East European Law School Network (SEELS), financially supported by GIZ Open Regional Fund for South East Europe-Legal reform and will be held in English language.

Eligible for participation are academics from the Faculties of Law (SEELS members) in Zagreb, Split, Sarajevo, Zenica, Skopje, Podgorica, Tirana, Belgrade, Niš and Kragujevac.

The candidates must either be working at one of these faculties, or have their PhD-diploma from one of them. They must have defended their PhD between 1 January, 2007 and 31 December, 2011.

There are no restrictions as to the number of candidates from a particular Faculty of Law. Every academic who meets the requirements has the right to be a candidate.

The candidate's dissertation may be in any field of private law, like civil law, family law, commercial law, labour law, competition law, private international law, civil procedure etc., including the European private law.

From all candidates, 20 academics shall be selected by the Selection Committee, in which all the ten SEELS Faculties of Law are represented. The 20 academics shall be invited to take part at the Colloquium in Zagreb with an oral presentation on a topic of their choice which is connected with their actual research. All expenses for these academics will be carried out by GIZ ORF-Legal reform.

After the colloquium (end of 2012) an international monograph with an international editorial body shall be published in English language, to which each of the 20 academics shall contribute a chapter. Such chapter shall consist of a scientific article on a topic that is connected with the academic's dissertation.

All other candidates shall have the right to participate at the colloquium in Zagreb as members of the auditorium.

Deadline for submission of applications is 15 March 2012.
