UN Women Europe and Central Asia (ECA) is looking for young activists to co-create and lead innovative actions that will help achieve a more equal and just future free from violence and discrimination.

In February 2021, UN Women ECA conducted consultations with National Gender Youth Activists (NGYAs) to discuss the challenges youth face in their activism and build the way forward. NGYAs prioritized thematic areas of work for UN Women's next four-year strategy and **demanded UN Women's support to expand their role as change agents at community, country, regional and global levels for addressing gender equality and women's empowerment.** Upon consultations, UN Women ECA launched its five-month initiative on youth participation and kicked it off through a youth-led campaign **#YOUthdemand.** 

Following the consultations, **#YOUthdemand** Campaign, and the Generation Equality Forum in Mexico, now it is time to create a free space for all of us to learn and brainstorm together, explore the tools we need to move from idea to action and plan how we will shake and transform our communities for better.

**#YOUthlead** workshops will take place between April 19 - May 23, 2021. You are expected to participate in two workshops and one learning cafe session per week (up to 2 hours per workshop). Participants are also required to work individually and in teams before and after the workshops (30 minutes per workshop).

The total expected dedication per week is of 7,5 hours. At the end of the workshops, you will be supported by UN Women ECARO with funding and mentorship to run your campaign between May 23- June 20, 2021.
